Each of the three drawers have fanciful impressive ormolu mounts. The side drawers have baskets of fruits and flowers amidst ribbons. Centered by the protruding middle drawer with two horn playing putti amidst musical instruments with scrolled foliate branches and birds on each side. At the top is a burgundy and gold tooled leather bordered by an ebony band and ormolu gallery. All original hardware and gilt. A truly statement making piece with sensational quality throughout.
