An exquisite French 19th century Transitional st. tulipwood, kingwood and Brocatelle Jaune marble Semainier cabinet. The Semainier is raised by handsome cabriole legs with fine foliate ormolu sabots. Above the scalloped shaped frieze are seven drawers, each finely decorated with berried laurel ormolu pulls and elegant richly chased pierced foliate ormolu keyhole escutcheons set on a butterfly veneered background. Each side displays four panels showcasing the beautiful wood grain, while each corner displays exceptional scrolled foliate ormolu mounts. Above is the original Brocatelle Jaune marble top with a fine mottled border.

The term "Semainier" is derived from the French word "Semaine" which translates to "week". A Semainier has seven drawers, one for each day of the week. A similar tall cabinet with six drawers is known as a chiffonier.
