A superb and very unique Belgian early 19th century Regency st. flamed Mahogany and brass inlaid buffet signed Bonneels. The three door three drawer buffet is raised by most elegant circular tapered topie shaped legs with finely fitted ormolu ball feet. Above the straight frieze are three doors each showcasing the stunning flamed Mahogany grain framed within a fine mottled band and delicate most decorative inlaid brass fillets.
