A stunning and extremely high quality French 19th century Louis XV st. kingwood and ormolu desk, attributed to François Linke. The desk is raised by elegant cabriole legs with fitted foliate sabots. Fine ormolu chutes lead up each leg to impressive richly chased foliate corner mounts in a striking satin and burnished finish. The drawer displays lovely a scalloped shape with an exceptional ormolu foliate fillet framing the beautifully inlaid parquetry background. The drawer is centered by intricately detailed pierced ormolu mounts with a charming cherub amidst scrolled foliate designs. Each sides and back also display beautiful diamond shaped parquetry framed within a foliate ormolu bands. Above is the masterfully inlays parquetry top showcasing the stunning wood grain and high level of craftsmanship. All framed within a kingwood band and mottled ormolu gallery. François Linke (1855-1946) Renowned 19th Century Parisian Ébéniste. Linke created historical interpretations of Louis XV and Louis XVI styles. He displayed at the Paris Universal Exhibition of 1900 where he received a gold medal.
