A stunning and extremely high quality French 19th century Louis XVI st. Belle Époque period Mahogany, ormolu and white Carrara marble buffet attributed to Henry Dasson. The three door three drawer buffet is raised by elegant topic shaped legs with fine fitted mottled ormolu sabots with lovely beaded bands and superb fluted foliate top caps. Above each leg are remarkable block rosettes flanking the straight frieze decorated with unique and most decorative swaging fabric like garlands with tassels. The central door and two elegantly curved side doors each showcase the exceptional Mahogany wood grain with delicate rosettes at each corner with a lovely beaded band framed within a fine mottled wrap around band. Above a lovely tied fluted band are the three drawers each displaying exquisite pierced scrolled foliate designs in a superb satin and burnished finish separated by charming richly chased blooming flowers tied with a ribbon. Above is the original white Carrara marble top with a fine mottled border. Henry Dasson (1825-1896) was a renowned 19th century Parisian maker of gilt-bronze mounted furniture. Dasson specialized in the production of Louis XIV, XV and XVI styles, using the finest gilt-bronze mounts and was recognized as a brilliant bronzier. Dasson was made a Chevalier of the Légion d'honneur in 1883 and was awarded the Grand Prix Artistique at the 1889 Paris Exposition Universelle.
