An exceptional and most impressive French 19th century Louis XVI st. Belle Époque period patinated bronze and ormolu lidded centerpiece planter. At the center is the charming finely detailed patinated bronze cherub standing on a ground designed base next to a tree trunk while draped in a wonderfully executed flowing garment while holding his hands in the air seemingly supporting the planter above. The elegantly shaped planter displays exceptional foliate designs throughout with a central scrolled family crest like reserve with a crown and charming seashell with lovely scrolled handles leading up each side. Above is the removable lid decorated with additional scrolled foliate designs with a top floral finial and which lifts off to reveal the finished interior.
