An exceptional and extremely unique French 19th century Louis XVI st. Kingwood and Vert Campan marble vanity sink cabinet attributed to Maison Krieger. The one door twelve drawer vanity is raised by a straight base with a fine wrap around mottled border. At the center is the single door decorated with a stunning quarter veneered diamond shaped design with a fine pierced foliate ormolu keyhole escutcheon and which opens to reveal the inside of the door decorated in the same manner and all original hardware. Flanking the door are six drawers at either side each decorated with beautiful foliate ormolu pulls and charming tied ribbon keyhole escutcheons set on guarter veneer backgrounds. The sides also display superb quarter veneered panels showcasing the beautiful wood grain. Above is the original Vert Campan marble top with the stunning original hand beaten fitted copper swivel sink with an ormolu top band and ormolu acanthus leaf handle. The sink can be tilted back to pour the water into the original copper drainage basin below. The Vert Campan marble backsplash displays four beautiful scrolled supports with richly chased floral and foliate designs below the top display shelf with a charming and most decorative pierced baluster ormolu gallery. May be used as a sink or wet bar.
