An extremely elegant and high quality French 19th century Louis XVI st. mahogany, kingwood, ormolu and Brocatelle d'Espagne marble side table, attributed to Linke. The circular table is raised by fine circular fluted tapered legs with delicate fitted foliate chandelles, lovely topic shaped feet and ormolu top and bottom crowns. Each leg is connected by a beautiful most decorative spiral geometric shaped stretcher with a fine beaded ormolu border. Above each leg are beautiful pierced ormolu mounts of urns with luxuriant overflowing flowers. At the apron are finely inlaid diamond shaped parquetry panels framed within an elegant mottled and beaded ormolu band.

At the front is one drawer centered by a superb, richly chased pierced berried laurel branch keyhole escutcheon. Above is the original Brocatelle d'Espagne fitted marble top framed within a stunning wrap around ormolu gallery with a charming wonderfully executed pierced heart shaped design.

All original gilt throughout.
