A striking and high quality French 19th century Louis XVI st. ormolu and silvered bronze six arm chandelier attributed to Henry Dasson. The chandelier is centered by a fine bottom berried finial amidst lovely foliate designs which encase the silvered bronze body. At the center and leaning on the central support are most charming and richly chased cherubs. Each cherub has an elegantly scrolled arm of the chandelier under each shoulder and leading out to foliate candle cups. In the direction of the top foliate canopy, are three exceptional chains displaying lyres and beautiful foliate patterns.

Henry Dasson (1825–1896) was a renowned 19th century Parisian maker of gilt-bronze mounted furniture. Dasson specialized in the production of Louis XIV, XV and XVI styles, using the finest gilt-bronze mounts and was recognized as a brilliant bronzier. Dasson was made a Chevalier of the Légion d'honneur in 1883 and was awarded the Grand Prix Artistique at the 1889 Paris Exposition Universelle.
