A most charming and high quality French 19th century Louis XVI st. patinated bronze and ormolu statue, signed E Drouot. The statue is raised by a circular ormolu base with a mottled border. The finely detailed winged cherub, possibly Cupid, is standing on a terrain designed base with his quiver at his feet. He displays a cute thoughtful pose with his hand raised to his mouth and his bow hidden behind his back. All original warm patina throughout.

Edouard Drouot (1859-1945) - Born in Sommevoir, France. Drouot was a student of Thomas and Mathieu Moreau. He received several medals and participated in the 1900 Parisian Exposition Universelle where he received an honorable mention.
