A magnificent French 19th century Louis XVI st. Rouge Griotte marble and ormolu clock by Raingo Frères, Paris. At the base are stunning ormolu mounts of rosettes and scrolled foliate, at the front and sides. The fluted marble body has a thick laurel wreath border and stunning draped foliate ormolu mounts. Centered above is the superb enamel dial within a chased ormolu case. At the top is an impressive Rouge Griotte urn decorated with ormolu bands and swaging foliate garlands, topped with a berried finial. Zacharie Joseph Raingo (1775-1839), Son of watchmaker Nicolas Raingo, a renowned clockmaker and bronzier, and founded Raingo Frères in 1813 Paris.
