A stunning French 19th century Neo-Classical st. ormolu, patinated bronze, and Rouge Griotte marble lamp signed Clodion. At the center is a wonderfully executed handsome man draped in a flowing garment and standing in front of a tree trunk on a ground designed base. An ormolu pan flute rests at his feet while he is seemingly holding up a fluted cornucopia above his head.
