A sensational and high quality French 19th century patinated bronze and gilt statue of native Americans lovers, signed D. Marie. The bronze is raised on a black Belgium marble base, decorated by an ormolu bottom band and a concave mottled edge. The man leans over his lover, who rests on his knee. Both richly adorned with native attire and gilt adornments. He is holding an ormolu oar and has an ormolu cross body quiver with arrows and a bow is next to the maiden.

Désiré-Pierre-Louis Marie, was a renowned mid 19th century French sculptor born in Le Calvados and was a student of of A. Toussaint. Marie exhibited his works at the Salon de Paris in 1861 and 1863.
