A striking French 19th century Renaissance st. ormolu and patinated bronze Warwick urn. The urn is raised by a circular ormolu base with a decorative fluted pattern and a Les Oves designs. The patinated bronze body displays richly chased Bacchic gods below the most decorative intertwining leaf and grape cluster rim with beaded and Les Oves patterns. Each side has magnificent intertwined handles with a fluted pattern. Also finished on the inside.

The Warwick Vase is an ancient Roman vase with Bacchic ornament that was discovered at Hadrian's Villa, Tivoli about 1771 by Gavin Hamilton, a Scottish painter-antiquarian and art dealer in Rome. It was restored by order of Sir William Hamilton and passed into the collection of his nephew, George Greville, 2nd Earl of Warwick.
