A fine French 19th century Transitional st. Tulipwood, Kingwood, Ormolu and Benou Breccia marble cabinet/secretary. The cabinet is raised on cabriole legs in the front with Ormolu sabot and two block supports in the back, with the bottom scalloped frieze being adorned with a wonderful pierced Ormolu mount of an urn. The bottom portion of the cabinet displays two doors with stunning quarter veneered Tulipwood and Kingwood inlays. Each door showcases a wonderful Ormolu keyhole escutcheon and opens to reveal one shelf and a concealed drawer which flips down allowing access to the leather topped writing surface. Above is the open display shelf with a lovely scalloped border and leading up to the Tambour sliding doors which open to give access to two additional drawers and various storage compartments. Both top front corners are elegantly designed with inlaid cut angles below the Yellow Benou Breccia marble top with a mottled border.
