An extremely elegant French late 19th century Louis XVI st. coffee table, attributed to Maison Jansen. The table is raised by circular tapered fluted legs connected by a fine X shaped stretcher with a circular central reserve. Above each leg are beautiful and richly chased foliate finials. The unique smoky glass top is framed within an ormolu border with a delicate wrap around fluted pattern.

Maison Jansen - Jean-Henri Jansen (1854-1929) had an outstanding reputation internationally. In 1885 Jansen was awarded a Silver Medal at both the 1883 Amsterdam Exhibition and the 1889 Exposition Universelle in Paris. Jansen's commissions included pieces for William III of the Netherlands, Alfonso XII of Spain and the Duke and Duchess of Windsor. Maison Jansen internationally renowned and were clients of François Linke.
