An exquisite French Turn-of-the-Century Louis XVI st. ormolu and mirrored three piece coffee table by Maison Jansen. The table is raised by unique and most decorative square tapered double legs connected by an elegant and impressive 'X' shaped stretcher. Above each leg are handsome richly chased lion heads set on a hammered background and framed within a mottled border. A beautiful pierced baluster designed gallery extends along the top border framing the original fitted mirror plates. All original gilding throughout.

Jean-Henri Jansen (1854-1929) - Maison Jansen had an outstanding reputation internationally. In 1885 Jansen was awarded a Silver Medal at both the 1883 Amsterdam Exhibition and the 1889 Exposition Universelle in Paris. Jansen's commissions included pieces for William III of the Netherlands, Alfonso XII of Spain and the Duke and Duchess of Windsor. Maison Jansen internationally renowned and were clients of François Linke.
