A most elegant and high quality pair of French 19th century Louis XVI st. Belle Époque period mahogany, ormolu and Sèvres porcelain side tables, attributed to Henry Dasson. Each table is raised by fine circular tapered fluted legs with beautiful foliate fitted ormolu sabots and elegant mottled top caps. Above each leg are beautiful richly chased foliate rosettes while the fronts display single drawers with most decorative central Sèvres porcelain plaques with lovely finely detailed hand painted fruits and charming flowers. The drawers also display two fine berried laurel pulls framed within an elegant mottled beaded ormolu band which is also repeated at the side. Above are the mahogany tops showcasing the striking mahogany grains framed within mottled ormolu galleries.

Henry Dasson (1825–1896) was a renowned 19th century Parisian maker of gilt-bronze mounted furniture. Dasson specialized in the production of Louis XIV, XV and XVI styles, using the finest gilt-bronze mounts and was recognized as a brilliant bronzier. Dasson was made a Chevalier of the Légion d'honneur in 1883 and was awarded the Grand Prix Artistique at the 1889 Paris Exposition Universelle.
