A stunning and most elegant pair of French 19th century Louis XVI st. Belle Époque period mahogany, ormolu, brass, and Trets marble consoles, singed Linke. Each console is raised by lovely topic shaped feet below lightly tapered fluted supports connected by fine bottom tiers with concave sides and elegant brass fillets at the borders. Above the front legs are striking fluted and reeded fitted ormolu reserves flanking the central drawers and concave sides. The drawers are centered by elegant ormolu keyhole escutcheons set on beautiful mahogany backgrounds and framed within lovely brass fillets. Above are the original fitted Trets marble tops framed within beautiful pierced ormolu galleries.

François Linke (1855-1946) Renowned 19th Century Parisian Ébéniste. Linke created historical interpretations of Louis XV and Louis XVI styles. He displayed at the Paris Universal Exhibition of 1900 where he received a gold medal.
