A sensational and extremely decorative pair of French mid 19th century Louis XVI st. cobalt blue Sèvres porcelain and ormolu lidded pot pourri urns. Each urn is raised by a square ormolu base with a superb Greek key design below the elegantly curved socle shaped pedestal support with richly chased

acanthus leaves with lovely interlocking and tied fluted wrap around bands.

The remarkable cobalt blue Sèvres porcelain body displays impressive intricately detailed lions at each side with exceptional attention to detail and hoops in their mouths connected by draped garments reminiscent of Hercules Nemean lion skin tied at the front. At the center are exceptional wrap around berried laurel and mirrored Vitruvian scrolls, and striking Greek key designs. The removable lid also displays the same stunning colored cobalt blue Sévres porcelain with a superb richly chased top foliate ormolu finial.
