Above the lovely arbalest shaped frieze are the two drawers, each decorated with an exceptional and most decorative circular central inlaid Kingwood reserve with exquisite mother of pearl accents flanked by richly chased scrolled foliate ormolu pulls set on a spectacular burl Elm background and framed within a fine herringbone and Cherrywood border. The sides also display striking circular central reserves with beautiful mother of pearl accents also set on a most decorative burl Elm background.
