An impressive and complete set of twelve French 19th century Louis XVI st. mahogany dining chairs, most likely by Mercier Freres, Paris. Each chair is raised on four square tapered legs, at the front decorated with acanthus leaf ormolu sabots. At the base of the seat are brass nails heads below a greyish teal ultra suede. The balloon shaped backs of the chairs are intricately decorated with brass fillets and a central ebonized wood sea shell motif, below another with a quarter veneered design. At each side are fine ormolu rosettes and atop is a richly chased ormolu mount.
