A most impressive large scale true pair of French 19th century patinated bronze Marly horse statues, after a model by Coustou. Each statue is raised by a rock and ground like designed base where the wonderfully detailed stallions are rearing while being handled by richly sculpted grooms. The grooms are draped in flowing garments and are holding their ormolu reins.

Wonderful proportions and all original patina throughout.

Guillaume Coustou, (1677-1746). Coustou was commissioned by Louis XV for the horse pond at the Chateau de Marly. In 1794 they were moved to the Place de la Concorde at the eastern end of the Champs-Élysées and later in 1894, these famous horses earned a place at the Louvre museum where they can still be seen today.
