The pedestal column is raised by a circular mottled base below the Rosso Levanto central support and finely detailed mottled top support. The statue above depicts a wonderfully executed and most charming young girl draped in a flowing garment with a basket of finely detailed flowers at her feet. She is reading the bible with the old testament verse Exodus 20:12 "V. Honor thy father and thy mother" inscribed inside. Wonderful attention to detail throughout.
