A stunning and large scale Italian patinated bronze statue, signed Picasso and from the Italian foundry of Sabatino Angelis & Fils, Naples, 1907. The statue is raised by a square base with a tree stump. The maiden is draped in elegant classical attire and holds a richly detailed bouquet of flowers in her left hand while her other hand holds up her garment. She displays a captivating gaze with her hair tied in an elegant fashion. All original stunning verdigris patina throughout. The Italian foundry of Sabatino de Angelis et Fils in Naples, was active in the late 19th and early 20th century, and was renowned for casting models of famous antiquities in the Museo Nazionale di Napoli. The bronzes were cast using the lost wax method and were given a variety of patina.
