A spectacular and highly important Italian First Empire period, circa 1810, ormolu, marble, alabaster and semi precious stone surtout de table attributed to Luigi Valadier (Rome 1726 -1785). The elongated oval ormolu pierced gallery has a richly chased design of scrolled foliage and central reserves of two lions flanking a family crest. The gallery is joined by four rectangular pediments with lion heads and swaging fruit garlands. Above are richly carved alabaster figures on pedestals holding lyres and folios. The plateau has an inlay of specimen marbles and semi precious stones including Lapis Lazuli and Blue John. Above are four alabaster Neo-Classical urns with removable lids on circular carved columns on square plinths. Museum quality.
